Sermon: Revelation: It's All About Jesus!
Text: Revelation 1:1-8

Read: Revelation 1:1-8

Discussion Questions

Icebreaker Question: What was your very first car, and did you name it?

Question #1: The Book of Revelation begins by stating that it is a 'revelation of Jesus Christ'. Can you think of one or two things in Revelation that relate to Jesus?

Additional Question: It says in verse 1 that what is found in Revelation 'must soon take place'. What thoughts arise in you when you hear that everything in this book will happen?

Question #2: Verse 3 says: "Blessed is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it."

What do you think it means to 'take to heart' what is written?

Additional Question: Read James 1:22-25. What things does a person need to do in order to live a 'blessed life' according to this passage?

Question #3: In 1:5 Jesus is referred to as the 'ruler of the kings of the earth.' A ruler is one who has the authority. What authority does Jesus have over the 'kings of the earth'. . .the ones who lead our governments?

Additional Question: The last part of 1:5 says "To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood."

Jesus has authority over sin and death, and has authority to grant eternal life! Think about the extent of earthly governmental authority and the authority of Jesus...how do they compare?

Question #4: 1:6 says that for those who have put their trust in Jesus that they have been made 'a kingdom of priests to serve his God and Father.'
In your mind what do priests do? And how does that line up with you because you are one!

Additional Question: We are a 'kingdom of priests'. A priest is one who ministered before the Lord, offering up worship to God, honoring Him, helping others to serve and worship Him. Jesus is called a priest in Hebrews 5. Can you think of how Jesus served God, and how you and I are called to do the same?

Question #5: Read 1:7. How does this passage affect you? What thoughts arise in you?

Additional Question: Verse 7 says that 'all people will mourn because of him.' What do you think this means?

This week your invitation is to step into asking the Lord what it means to be one of His priests here on earth, here in Strasbourg and surrounding area. Ask Him to show you what He wants your life to show forth to the world about Jesus?
