### Discussion Questions

Question #1:

Rob Reimer in his book "Soul Care" says this: "There can be no transformation where there is no revelation. We cannot overcome that which we will not admit."

Jesus says in John 15 that He loves you just like the Father loves Him, and that this love is meant to produce *joy* in you.

Do you believe that Jesus loves you? Does this fill you with joy? If no joy then you may need a revelation of His love in your life. One way to step toward this

is to confess to Jesus that you don't really feel joy because of His love and that you want that.

Take a moment in your group for anyone who wants to be prayed for a revelation of Jesus' love that produces joy.

**Question #2:**

Jesus said that we are to love each other just like He loves us.

Take a minute to talk about how you think Jesus loves us.

Can you think of someone that you do love like that?

Can you think of someone that you don't love like that?

**Question #3:**

Sometimes it's incredibly hard to love like Jesus loves. But we should be encouraged that He is with us to make this happen. He says that we did not choose Him but that He chose you and I and then gave us a task to bear fruit that will last. This fruit is loving like He does.

Men: how would you imagine it looks like for you to show love to someone?

Women: how would you imagine it looks like for you to show love to someone?

**Invitation and Mission for this week**

Since Jesus said that our task is to love each other, then it would make sense that we try and do that in obedience to Him this week.

Help each other come up with one simple task that you could do this week to show love to someone else.
