Luke 2:25-35

Discussion Questions

Question #1:

In Luke 2:29-32 it says that salvation has been sent to people as a light for revelation.

What kind of revelation does the light of Jesus bring to people?

Question #2:

In verse 34 it says that ‘this child’ (Jesus) is destined to cause the ‘falling and rising of many’. This means that some will accept Him as Saviour and others will reject Him.

How does this make you feel?

Question #3:

In looking at question #2, how do you think your life should reflect the message of Jesus' salvation toward others?

Question #4:

Read what the angel declared in Luke 2:14, and then read what Jesus says in Luke 12:51-53.

The angel declared 'peace' upon those whose God's favor rests, and then Jesus saying that He is not bringing peace for everyone. There will be 'three against two, and two against three' in 12:52.

This indicates that the favor and peace of Jesus *is* resting on some but others who are disagreeing are not receiving peace and favor.

How do you explain this?

Question #5:

Are you at peace with Jesus? Have you accepted Him as your Saviour? If not you can do so by asking Him to forgive your sins and to fill you with His Spirit.

If you know others who are not living in the peace of Jesus, you can pray that they would hear and receive salvation as well.

Invitation and Mission for this week

This week's mission is simple: that you pray for the salvation of your family, friends and neighbours that they would live with the favor and peace of Jesus in relationship with Him.
