Discussion Questions

Question #1:

The question of 'first importance' has to do with your response to Jesus' death and resurrection: do you believe that He died and was raised from the dead to break the power of sin over humanity? And do you believe that He did this for you?

Question #2:

Paul said that he was undeserving of being called an apostle because he had persecuted the church of God.

Stop and ask yourself this question: Have you persecuted the church of God?

Question #3:

Paul said "I am what I am", meaning that Jesus had saved him, given him new life and was literally a brand new man. He was no longer defining himself by past sins but living in the new reality of being a transformed son of God.

Do you see yourself like this?

Question #4:

Paul said that God's grace in his life 'did not prove vain' which can be taken a couple of ways. One way is to see how he responded to God's transformation by choosing to live it out so the whole world could see the love of Jesus through him.

Can you imagine your life being a shining reflection of Jesus' love to the world around you?
