Hebrews 10:1-14

Discussion Questions

Question #1: It's never easy to give up something that has become meaningful in our lives.

Can you think of an example when you had to sacrifice something important in your life?

Question #2: In surrender there is always sacrifice.

Read Hebrews 2: 9 What do you think Jesus sacrificed in his surrender?

Question #3: Does God call us to surrender and sacrifice in our lives with Him?

Read Philippians 1:21 and think about how this might affect your life today.

Question #4: Jesus says in Hebrews 10:7 “Here I am—it is written about me in the scroll—I have come to do your will, O God.”

What thoughts go through your mind when you know that Jesus was prepared to do the Father’s will, and that this surrender led Jesus to this: Read Isaiah 52:14 and then Isaiah 53:4-5.

Question #5: Read Romans 12:1-2 and ask yourself this: “What is God calling me to in this life?”

Invitation and Mission for this week

This week take some time to take God’s call on your life seriously. Jesus did, and it changed everything.

Prayerfully meditate on Romans 12:1-2 and ask Jesus to show you what this is supposed to mean in your life.
